Dear Friends:

The FCAP ministry continues to impact the airline/aviation world in 2026. From conferences around the world ... to jumpseat interactions ... to cockpit conversations ... to break room chats about Jesus, new believers are experiencing the joy of Christ in their lives and the support from our organization. FCAP members are mobilized and equipped to respond in moments of crisis and comfort.

Here is a brief overview of several things that have taken place in 2025:

- FCAP now has a **phone app**, a wonderful tool for better connecting airline/aviation people throughout the world...connecting them with the Lord Jesus, connecting them with all our ministry has to offer, and connecting them with one another.
- We enjoyed a wonderful time together in fellowship, teaching, prayer, and activities at our 2025 **FCAP International Conference** held in the U.S. This time resulted in formation of new outreach at local bases and partnerships with other like-minded ministries (i.e. Pilots for Christ and Wings of the Way). Response from participants at the conference has been most positive.
- **Outreach to students** attending schools offering aviation programs has been expanded. Two student chapters are now officially in place at LeTourneau University and Liberty University. Visits to many other schools have laid the groundwork for formation of student chapters at other locations as well. In conjunction with outreach to students, FCAP had the privilege this past summer to help sponsor a VBS program designed specifically for kids interested in aviation.
- Several have come to saving faith in Christ through outreach at the **Boise Airport Chapel**. God has continued to answer prayer there... one being the smooth transition as Warren Milanowski passed on the baton of directorship of the Chapel to Andy Pietila.
- Prayer walks and evangelistic outreach in **Frankfurt, Germany** have been an encouragement to many, and they too have seen people come to saving faith in Jesus.
- We have seen a resurgence of ministry outreach in **Canada**.
- Deepening relationships and encouragement in the faith have resulted from time spent together **online in Fellowship & Prayer**. Men and ladies have met on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of each month (breakout rooms), with Engaging in Prayer (for everyone together) taking place on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday.
- Our third year with FCAP represented at the **EAA AirVenture in Oshkosh** was once again such a blessing as we connected with airline/aviation personnel and enthusiasts from around the world. Not only were many introduced to the availability of FCAP, but even more importantly individual conversations often led to sharing the Gospel with those who do not yet know Christ.

Now to give you a glimpse into plans for 2026:

- On February 21-28, our annual **FCAP Ski Adventure** will be enjoyed by many in the beautiful Austrian alps.

- Our **2026 International Conference** will take place in Nairobi, Kenya on April 7-11. FCAP groups in Kenya and Uganda have been working hard in planning this event. In addition to time together in fellowship at a beautiful conference center, in going deeper into God's Word, and in prayer, they are also planning an excursion day on a safari and an onsite visit with a partner ministry, AIM Air. - Our fourth year at the **EAA AirVenture** is on the calendar for July 20-26. We are trusting the Lord for additional volunteers and finances as this year we are expanding to a second booth location: one in the IAMA Tent and the second in Hanger D. (*Please contact us if you are interested in being a part of our Oshkosh team, whether through personal involvement or prayer/financial support.*)
- **Outreach to schools offering aviation programs** is expanding. This includes colleges/universities, high schools, and private aviation schools). It is our heart desire to help prepare students for the mission field God has before them. Again, we are trusting God for open doors and additional resources to bring this to fruition. We are looking toward expansion in VBS outreach as well for young people interested in aviation.
- Outreach through the **Boise Airport Chapel** continues through Chaplain Doug Human, Andy Pietila, and others coming on board to join their team.
- Last year we witnessed re-establishment of a FCAP group in the **New York City/Newark** area and prospect of one in **the Los Angeles** area. We are praying the same will take place in other locations, especially in North and South America.
- **Training for workplace ministry** will continue, both online and in person.
- In addition to revamping our website, we will continue making available numerous resources to help fulfil our mission to **Edify, Engage, Encourage, and Excite** as we seek to minister to airline/aviation personnel throughout the world, both in sharing the Gospel and helping Christians grow in their faith and walk with Christ.
